Host to the Painted Lady butterfly and Skippers

Soil Description: Sandy or gravelly soils, but will grow in

other soils

Bloom time: summer

Swamp milkweed (Asclepias incarnate)



Host to Monarch and Queen butterflies

Light Requirement: Sun, Part Shade

Soil Moisture: Moist, Wet

Soil Description: Rich, wet, very muddy to average garden

moisture. Prefers neutral to slightly acidic soil but will

tolerate heavy clay. **Bloom time:** summer

Great blue lobelia (Lobelia siphilitica)
